Indoor use

Protective earth symbol (in protection class I)

Proper use

Your smart adaptor is designed to switch the power supply of a connected appliance on or off via the MEDION® LIFE+ app.

The adaptor is designed to be connected with a router so that a connected appliance such as a lamp can be turned on or off remotely. The MEDION® LIFE+ app allows you to access the adaptor from your smartphone or tablet. Note that no liability will be accepted if the device is not used for its intended purpose:

- Do not modify the device without our express agreement and do not use any accessories that have not been supplied or approved by us.
- Only use replacement parts or accessories that we have supplied or approved.
- Comply with all the information in these operating instructions, especially the safety information. Any other use is improper and might cause personal injury or damage to property.
- Only use the device indoors.
- Do not use the device in extreme ambient conditions.

Safety information

This device can be used by children of 8 years and older, and by people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacity, or with a lack of experience and/or knowledge, but only with proper supervision, or if they have been told how to use the device safely, and have understood the risks involved if they use it improperly.

- Children must not be allowed to play with the device.
- Keep the device and its accessories out of the reach of children.






Never use several adaptors connected in series.



Setting up the adaptor for the first time via the MEDION® LIFE+ app

- Connect your smartphone/mobile device to the same WLAN network that you want to connect the adaptor to.
- Install the MEDION® Smart Home app.




Menu structure of MEDION® LIFE+ app

Creating a profile

- Start the MEDION® LIFE+ app.

- Click **Create new account**.
- Choose your region using the Country Code (mandatory field).
- Enter your email address and your first and last name (mandatory fields).
- Tick the box to accept the data protection declaration (optional).
- Tick the box to accept the data protection provisions and terms and conditions (mandatory field).
- Click **Continue** to proceed.
- Enter the confirmation code that was sent to the email address you provided, and assign a password.
- Click **Continue** to proceed.

- Click **Start your Smart Life.**
- Enter your **Home Name** to assign a name to your location.
- Select your **Family Location** to define the location of your devices.
- Choose a room (e.g. kitchen) in which you want to use the device. These settings can be adjusted later (see "Additional settings").
- Click **Done** to finish creating the profile and then confirm the pop-up message again.

Setting up the adaptor

- Ensure that your smartphone is connected to your WLAN.
- Click **Add Device** or the **+** symbol in the upper right-hand corner.
- Then click **Electrical outlet.**

i If the LED on the adaptor does not blink, press and hold the On/Off button for a few seconds until the LED blinks.


- Click **Confirm indicator blinks rapidly.**
- Connect your smartphone/tablet with the WLAN network you want to use to switch the adaptor.
- Enter the access details for your network.
- Click **Confirm.**

i If you want to use another WLAN network later, click **Change Network** and select another WLAN network.

i Only 2.4 GHz networks are supported.

- The app will now search for the adaptor, connect it to the Cloud and register it in your user account.
 - Assign a name to the adaptor and click **Save** to confirm the input.
 - Allocate the adaptor to a room (optional).
 - Click **Done** to finish connecting the adaptor.
- You can now set up and control the adaptor with the app.
- If the installation is not successful, restart the app and try again.

- Click the adaptor symbol to specify additional settings.

This opens the settings menu of the WLAN adaptor.

You control the WLAN adaptor in the start interface of the settings menu.

Switch

- Switch the appliance on or off.

Countdown

- Set a countdown time, after which the appliance will be switched off.


Timer

- You can set a timer for the time when the appliance is turned on and off.
- Also choose whether the task should be carried out every

day or only on certain days of the week.

Additional settings

- Click the **⋮** button to define further settings for the adaptor. Follow the instructions in the app.



Restore factory settings

- Select the adaptor in the device list.
- Click the **⋮** button to open the settings menu for the adaptor.
- Click **Reset** and confirm your input with **Confirm** in the pop-up message.

When the factory settings have been restored, the status LED will blink. The adaptor has now been reset and is ready to be connected to a network again.

Cleaning

The device does not contain any parts that require cleaning or maintenance.



PLEASE NOTE! Possible damage to property

- Do not let the device come into contact with water or other liquids.
- Do not use solvents, corrosive or gaseous cleaning agents.
- Before cleaning, turn off the power point and pull out the mains plug.
- If necessary, the housing can be wiped down with a slightly damp cloth.

- Switch off the power point and pull out the plug.
- Store the device in a dry, dust-free location out of direct sunlight.
